Anne Stone - Anne was referred to us in January 2014 by First Point. Anne had suffered brain damage as a child from a whooping cough vaccination, this left her with educational difficulties. Anne's training started in January 2014, for two days per week in our Cafe and Sandwich round. She left training to start her new job in July 2014.

Anne had little confidence in herself and abilities, but she was keen to learn and improve her skills. Anne took the Food safety Level 2 exam just eight weeks after starting with us and passed, then proceeded to pass her level 2 in Health & Safety in the workplace a month later. Anne continued to progress achieving her quarterly goals, making great strides in sandwich preparation, delivery service, making hot drinks, serving food, customer service and would often cover for another trainee going holiday. Anne's skills soared giving her the confidence to apply for part-time paid work at a local primary school, as a lunch time supervisor. Anne got the position she applied for and left our training programme after just seven months, feeling very positive about her future.
